10:05-10:35 | Cap Manzamo

Manza-mo is a national natural park located on the west coast of Okinawa Island in Onna Village. Its name originates from the Ryukyu King Shō Kei's praise of it as "a grassy area large enough for ten thousand people to sit." The landscape centers around a 20-meter-high Ryukyu limestone cliff, forming a coral reef cliff resembling an elephant's trunk. The cliff's summit is covered by a natural grassland spanning 300,000 square meters.

11:25-11:55 | Kouri Island

Kouri Island is home to Okinawa's version of the Adam and Eve creation myth, where the ancestors of the Ryukyu people are said to have lived in caves along Chinugu Beach. Key attractions include the turquoise waters hailed as "Okinawa's most beautiful sea," the heart-shaped rock formation at Tinu Beach, and the Kouri Ocean Tower observation deck.





12:25-15:25 | Churaumi Aquarium

Okinawa Churaumi Aquarium showcases the mysterious marine life of Okinawa. Visitors can touch starfish, sea cucumbers, and other creatures inhabiting coral reefs. [Free Dolphin Show (approx. 10 min): 1:00 PM / 3:00 PM]

16:45-17:45 | American Village

Mihama American Village recreates the streetscape of America's West Coast through brick pathways, coconut tree decorations, and seaside graffiti walls. Its core area, Depot Island, hosts over 100 shops and restaurants featuring American cuisine, Japanese local brands, and Okinawan specialties. Landmark facilities include the 7 Plex cinema, a 3D imaging entertainment center, and a 50-meter-diameter Ferris wheel.
